We have GREAT news!

The U.S. Supreme Court has decided against prohibiting indoor worship in California. The news from the high court was issued late Friday

evening, February 5, 2021. ***What does this mean for us?*** Starting today, Saturday, February 6, 2021, we are back inside our Church to celebrate Mass! In doing so, however, we will still follow all other public health protocols including washing hands frequently, hand sanitizing, wearing masks, physical-distancing and contact tracing.

Other information to know:

- The Court order kept in place the State prohibition on singing and chanting indoors.
- Indoor services are limited to 25% of the building's capacity. For our Church - 250 maximum people!
- Communion will start from the back pews—**ONE line** per aisle, please!

Contact Tracing:

Wouldn't you want to know . . . ? ? ? As part of the safety precaution, we are mandated to do contact tracing. As we have learned from this pandemic – communication is vital and important! Therefore, as you enter the church - EACH TIME YOU attend Mass, you will need to provide the following information on a ¼ sheet of paper (OLMC we will provide):

- Name of head of household *
- Number of people in your household attending Mass with you *
- Phone number and or email address *
- Address (optional)

ALL of the above information is * REQUIRED in order for you to attend Mass at OLMC. An Usher will be handing out the Form (¼ sheet of paper) for you to fill out – either at the gate (as you enter the parking lot) or in the courtyard. Please have your form completed **BEFORE** you enter the Church. **This will help expedite entrance and a peaceful transition inside the Church.** In lieu of the form, any sheet of paper from home will suffice as long as the above required information is written down for contact tracing purposes!
